Any automobile accident is a traumatic experience. Even when you don't believe you were injured and the damage to the vehicles involved is minimal, the event can still be upsetting. This pamphlet has helpful guidelines for you to follow in the event you are in an accident. Many problems can be avoided or lessened if you know what steps to take.

If You Are Involved In An Accident

- 1) If possible move your vehicle away from the path of oncoming traffic.
If the vehicle cannot be moved off of the road, put on your emergency blinkers and place a warning to oncoming traffic down the road.
Never leave the scene of an accident! It's against the law to not stop in the event of an accident that you are involved in.
- 2) Assist the injured.
- 3) Call the police and request other emergency assistance as needed.
- 4) Watch what you say.
- 5) Obtain the names and addresses of all witnesses.
- 6) Exchange information with the other driver(s) involved.
- 7) Seek medical attention.

Stop



The law requires that the driver of any vehicle involved in a accident must stop. Pull your vehicle over to the side of the road or other safe place, away from traffic, if possible.

Assist The Injured



Your first responsibility after stopping is to assist any person who was injured. If someone is seriously injured, immediately call for an ambulance or doctor. Call 911. **DO NOT MOVE SERIOUSLY INJURED PERSONS.** Only qualified persons should give emergency medical assistance.

Report The Accident



Call (or have someone else call) the local police department to report the accident. It is always advisable to have the police at the scene of an accident so a report can be filed. If liability has to be established, their report will be invaluable.

Watch What You Say



Always tell the truth, but be careful not to admit any fault. Even if you feel you are to blame, only tell what happened. Just tell the police the facts as to what happened. It is always best to get legal advice as quick as possible.

Witnesses



Write down the names, addresses and phone numbers of anyone who witnessed the accident or can offer information about the accident, including any information you can obtain about what the witnesses observed.

Exchange Information



If possible obtain the name and phone number of the other driver. Also, obtain their driver's license number, address, vehicle license plate number, make and year of car and VIN number.

See Your Doctor Immediately



If there is a chance you were injured, it is very important that you immediately go to the emergency room or see your doctor. It is best to be checked out by a doctor. You may not know you are hurt or you may have hidden injuries.

See Your Lawyer



Car accidents can cause injuries that insurance companies may regard as minor or irrelevant and may not want to pay for. You will need an experienced lawyer who will fight for your best interests. Don't sign any documents until you have consulted with a lawyer. You could be signing away your legal right to a fair and just settlement.
